Aligning Careers in Bomet, Kericho and Narok Counties through Bootcamps

In the month, our officers also participated in a bootcamp organised by the Kenya Students Christian Fellowship, where they engaged learners from Bomet, Kericho, and Narok counties. During the forum, the officers sensitised 1,100 secondary school students, 150 KCSE graduates, 55 teachers, 28 junior secondary learners and 31 college students on placement to learning opportunities and career pathways. 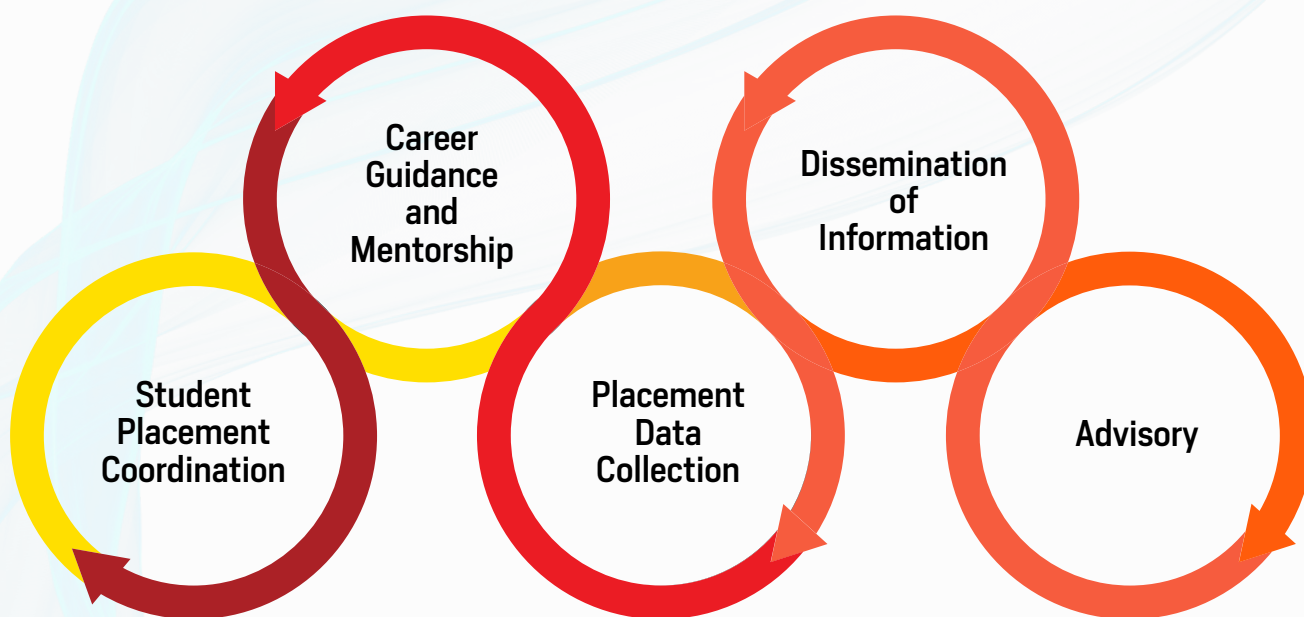
