## 2026 KUCCPS APPLICATIONS: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**1. I applied for degree programmes and I have secured a provisional placement. Can I make changes to my application during revision of choices?**

Once you have secured a provisional placement, you cannot make any changes and need not to take any further action but wait for the official release of placement results.

**2. I applied previously and I was placed in a diploma/certificate programme yet I qualified for degree. Can I apply for university this year?**

If two years have not passed since you were placed, you can apply for inter-institutional transfer from your TVET institution to a university of your choice and select a degree programme. The transfer application will open after the official released of placement results in July 2026.

**3. I sat KCSE in 2024 and qualified for university but I did not apply for placement. I would like to apply this year. What should I do?**

Send an official request to KUCCPS, providing your name, KCSE index number, KCSE year and reasons why you did not apply for degree programmes in 2025. E-mail your request to [info@kuccps.ac.ke](mailto:info@kuccps.ac.ke) and KUCCPS will guide you on the next steps.

**4. When are you going to re-open application for KMTC programmes, especially Nursing?**

Some KMTC programmes are currently available for application in the KUCCPS system, for immediate intake. However, for other programmes such as Nursing, the next application, for the September 2026 intake, will open from June/July 2026. **5. I am interested in Diploma in Primary Teacher Education Programme but I cannot find it in the KUCCPS portal. How can I apply?**

The programme is currently not available for application.

**6. I paid the application fee but I was not able to submit my application for degree programmes?**

**Do I have to pay afresh when applying during the current revision of choices?**

You do not have to pay again. Use your previous payment details to submit your application before the deadline. The final degree application window will close on June 1, 2026.

**7. When are you going to re-open application for TVET programmes for 2026 intakes?**

The KUCCPS online system is currently open for TVET applications. It will close on June 8, 2026.

**8. Are students who sat for KCSE in previous years eligible to apply?**

Form four leavers who sat KCSE from 2000 to 2025 are eligible to apply for TVET programmes, while only those from 2025 with mean grades of C+ and above can apply for degree programmes.

**9. How can students who have not yet obtained National Identity Cards apply for placement?**

A National ID Card is not a mandatory requirement for KUCCPS applications. If you do not have an ID, skip it and fill in other contact details when starting your KUCCPS application.

**10. Can a student change a course after submitting an application?**

Yes. Applicants may edit their choices before the application deadline.

**11. What are KUCCPS telephone numbers?**

The official KUCCPS telephone numbers are **0205137400** and **0713924444**.

**12. Does KUCCPS handle transfers from one programme/course to another within the same university/TVET institution?**

The inter-programme transfer process (changing from one programme to another) is done within the institution through the relevant department or faculty. For degree programmes, the university must still observe the required programme cut-off points and admission requirements before approving any transfer.
